Grant Eligibility Guidelines and Application Instructions

Grants will be given on the combined basis of:

1. Scholarship need
2. Merit: based upon submitted Video (include examples of teaching and student performances)

(30 minute (total) maximum length)

Eligibility:

1. You must be a 501(c)3 organization
2. An Alum of The String Academy of Wisconsin **or** UW-Milwaukee's String Pedagogy, Masters degree or SAW Summer Teacher workshops **must be a member of your faculty.**

One Grant Cycle per fiscal year.

2024-2025 year Grants are limited up to \$10,000 each.

Application Process:

1. Download and complete forms for Application and Project Budget.
2. Prepare a video and upload as **unlisted** on YouTube.

Video requirements: Length: up to 30 minutes

To include:

- a. Sample teaching
- b. Performance of 3 students (various levels), and an ensemble

this is part of your program
